

Contemporary Indigenous artist Joshua Wawa Jungerboi is a proud Ngugi & Geonpul man and descendant of the Jungerboi, Tjunobin & Nidgiri first nations peoples.

He is currently living and working on Tjerrangerri/Minjerribah (North Stradbroke Island) which is where he has spent many years honing his skills and gaining inspiration from the natural environment of his ancestral homeland and culture surrounding him.

His artwork is a reflection of his connection to country, and whilst he is well known for his diverse range of traditional and contemporary drawings and paintings, he is most passionate about working with nature and creating beautifully individual and unique wood burnt products and didgeridoos that he sources in raw untouched form, then uses his shaping and creative skills to transform the raw product into fully functional and stunning musical instruments.

Joshua Wawa Jungerboi is drawn to his homeland Minjerribah and will continue to use his connection to country to inspire him wherever his work takes him.
